# **APPROVAL OF MINUTES:**

President Long said the minutes of the April 20, 2023, Enterprise Board meetings were posted to OnBoard and the website for review and asked if there were any corrections or additions. Hearing none, Mr. Garcia, seconded by Mr. Edelmann to approve the minutes. Motion unanimously carried.

#### TREASURER REPORT:

Mrs. Nichols reported the financial statements for April 2023, were posted to OnBoard and the Board website for review. Mrs. Nichols moved, seconded by Mr. Clayton, for acceptance of the April 2023 financial statements and payment of the May 2023 bills. Motion unanimously carried.

#### **ACTION ITEM:**

# FRYINGPAN ARKANSAS PROJECT WATER AND RETURN FLOW ALLOCATION

Mr. Garrett Markus presented an action item, in the form of a PowerPoint to the Board to approve the allocation of 42,282 acre-feet (AF) of Fry-Ark Project Water (Project Water) (22,103 AF for municipal use and 20,179 AF for agricultural use) and the allocation of 7,098 AF of Project Water Return Flows (Return Flow) based off the May 1, 2023, import basis for allocation of 55,400 AF. Seventy percent (70%) of the imports will be made available for allocation to municipal and agricultural entities following payment for one hundred percent (100%) of the allocation. The remaining thirty percent (30%) will be made available when the District is confident that imports will meet Project obligations. If any portion of the remaining thirty percent (30%) of allocated water is not available to the entities at that time, that portion of their Project Water payments will be refunded.

Anticipated Project Water and surcharge revenues resulting from this Project Water and Project Water Return Flow allocation are expected to be \$43,295 lower than, or 94.67 percent, of the 2023 Budget.

Mr. Hamel moved, seconded by Mr. May, the Board allocate 42,282 AF of Project water and 7,095 AF of Return Flows. Project water allocations would be available initially at seventy percent (70%) of the projected import amount available to municipal and agricultural entities following payment for 100 percent (100%) of the allocation. The remaining thirty percent (30%) would be made available when the District is confident that imports will meet Project obligations. If any portion of the remaining thirty percent (30%) of allocated Project water is not available to the entities at that time, that portion of their Project water payments will be refunded.

Questions were opened to the Board. Mr. Kastner of *Sunset View Water Company* asked that Mr. Markus explain to the Board the issues with his water allocation request. The well companies request could not be met due to issues associated with 1979 Allocation Principals. District staff is working to resolve the issue.

#### PRESENTATION ITEM:

#### AVC GROUNDBREAKING VIDEO

Mr. Woodka presented a video, showing the April 28, 2023, Bureau of Reclamation, and the Southeastern Colorado Water Conservancy District groundbreaking for the Arkansas Valley Conduit (AVC) at the construction staging site in Pueblo County near the connection point of the AVC with Pueblo Water's system. The video shows key points in the addresses given at the groundbreaking.

One major highlight was that Margie Medina, of SECWCD, was part of the lineup of individuals that shoveled dirt for the groundbreaking. This honor was given to her since she has the longest tenure at the District Office.

Christine Arbogast of Kogosovek & Associates was unable to attend the Board meeting. She did send in a copy of a letter from John Hickenlooper and Michael Bennet to Honorable Camille Touton of the Bureau of Reclamation, thanking her for her attendance at the event and continued support to the project. A hard copy of the letter was given to the Board.
